
Challenge 1: Origami Envelope


Post your letter in an envelope that's created by you!


- 


1. Pop out the letter along the perforated lines.
- 


2. Fold all the green lines firmly, then unfold them.
- 


3. Take the two top corners and fold them down to the horizontal green line.
- 

4. Take the two sides and fold them inward to the vertical green line.
- 

5. Fold the top flap down till it touches the diagonals made in step 3.
- 

6. Keep the top flap pressed down and fold the paper along the green horizontal line.
- 

7. Fold the remaining bottom portion up to the green line.
- 

8. Unfold the envelope and insert the bottom portion into the top's opening.
- 

9. Fold the top flap down. Your envelope is ready!

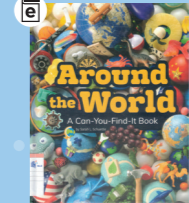
