

Holiday Specials: Flutter Butterfly

Materials needed:

- A piece of cardboard
- A piece of Coloured tissue paper
- A piece of Coloured paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- A pair of googly eyes
- Pipe cleaners for the butterfly's antennae
- Glue and
- Balloon

1. Start by cutting a cardboard in a shape of a square (approx.: 30cm x 30cm)



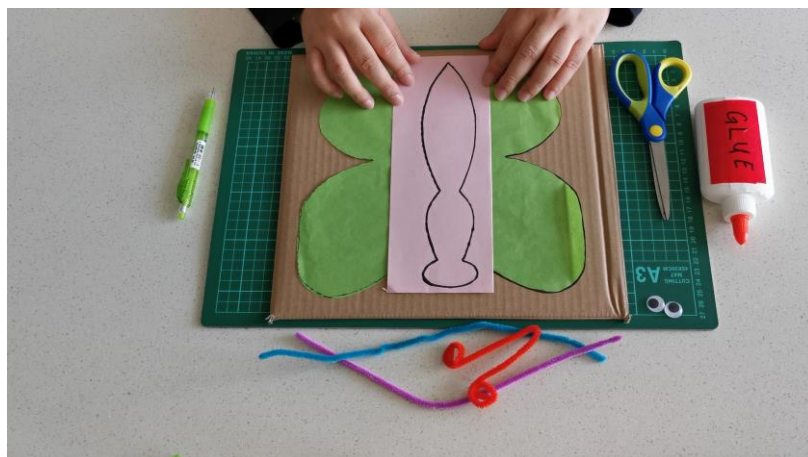
2. Fold the coloured tissue paper in half and use your pencil to draw butterfly wings on your tissue paper.



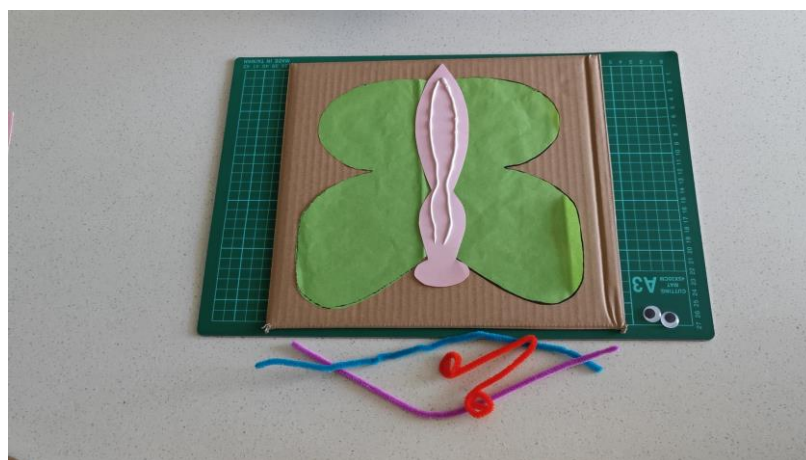
3. Cut the wings out. Set the wings onto your cardboard. Remember NOT to glue them onto the cardboard!



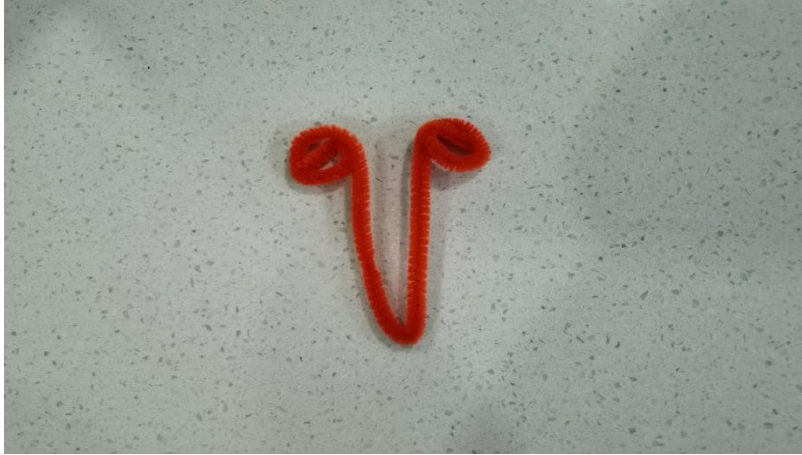
4. Draw a butterfly body on the coloured paper and cut it.



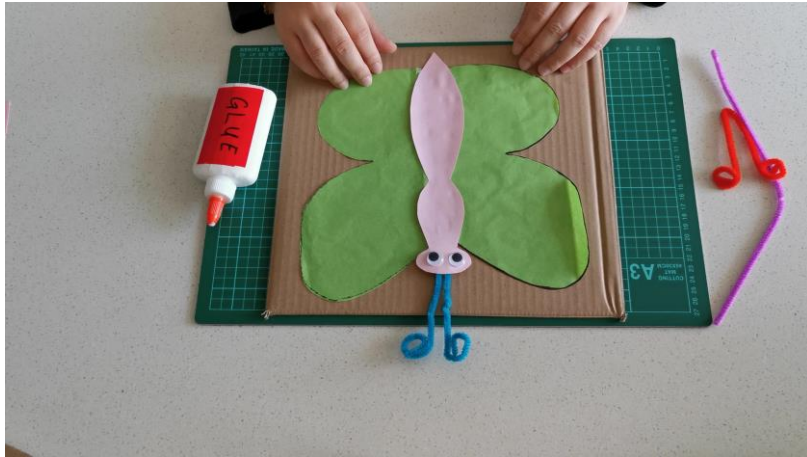
5. Next, place some glue on the body of the paper but not on the head. Once there is enough glue, put the paper right in the centre of the butterfly's wings.



6. Bend the pipe cleaners into half and roll both shown below. Place it underneath the head of the butterfly.



7. Last but not least, glue the googly eyes on the butterfly. Now you have your butterfly!
