# Holiday Specials: Spot the Rhyming Words 

## Materials needed:

- 1 kitchen paper roll
- 2 pieces of A4 size colored paper
- Marker
- A pair of scissors
- Double-sided tape
- Dot stickers (optional)

1. Use the marker to write all 26 letters of the alphabet on a piece of A4 paper or write the letters on dot stickers and paste them on a piece of A4 paper.

2. Wrap the paper around the kitchen paper roll and secure it with double-sided tape.

3. Push the excess paper, at both sides, inwards into the kitchen paper roll.

4. Cut a strip of paper from the second piece of A4 paper. Do ensure it is long enough to go one round around the kitchen paper roll.

5. Cut a square on the strip of paper and write the ending sound "AT" after the square. (Note: Parents, do assist your child if they need help with cutting.)

6. Wrap the strip of paper around the kitchen paper roll and secure with double-sided tape.

7. Rotate the strip of paper around the kitchen paper roll, to fit the different letters into the square, one at a time. How many valid rhyming words can you find?

8. You may also create different strips of paper with other ending sounds, such as "AP" or "AN".
