Holiday Specials: Make Your Own Solar System Mobile!

Materials needed:

- Long chopstick or wooden dowel
- White stock paper or drawing block paper
- Tape or white glue
- Thread
- Colouring materials
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Cut at least 10 pieces of different-sized circles out of the white stock paper or drawing block paper. Ensure that each piece of circle has its matching pair.



2. Colour and design the front and back of each piece of circle. You can also add sequins and other decorative materials.





3. Cut a slit halfway through each piece of circle.



4. Fit two matching circles together. You may use some glue or tape if the pieces do not stay in place.



5. Cut a piece of thread of varying length for each pair of circle and a longer piece for the chopstick/dowel.





6. Attach the end of the thread into the fold of the circle using tape or white glue.



- 7. Tie each circle to the chopstick/dowel.
- 8. Tie the longest thread around the ends of the chopstick/dowel.
- 9. Yay! You have made your own solar system mobile. You can hang it on the wall, window or anywhere you like!
