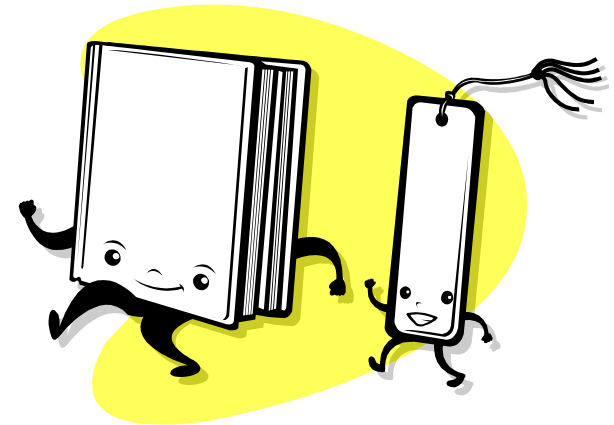

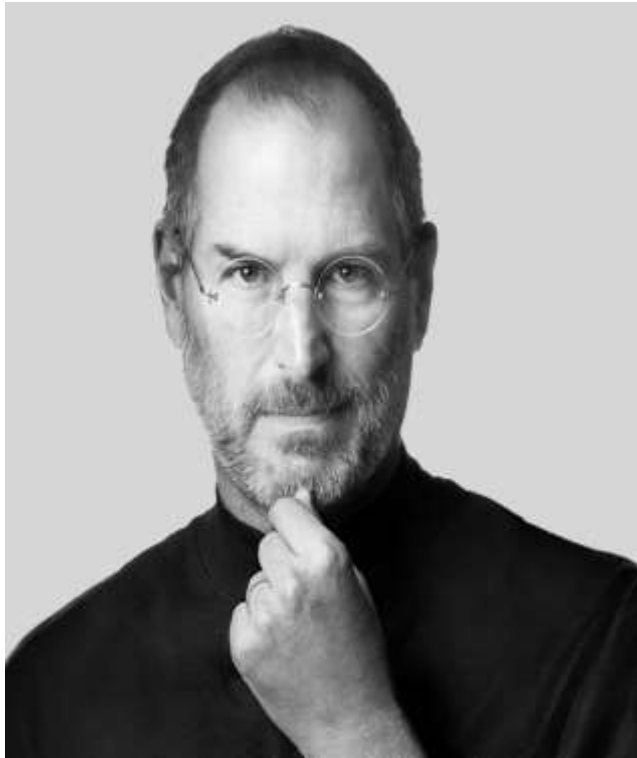


Walter Elias

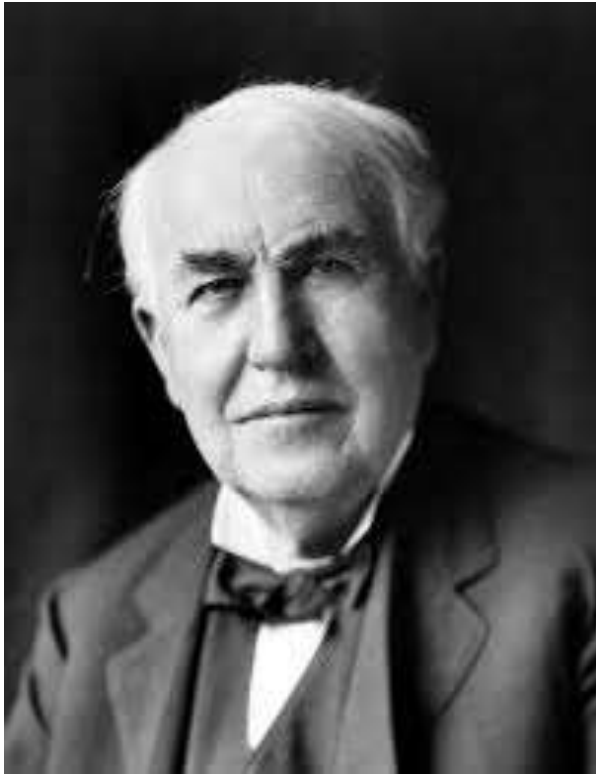


Steve Jobs



Why is it difficult to read?

- Words are not spaced correctly 

- Words are flying 

- Alphabets are flipped: p/b/d, w/v etc.



When some people look at a page the words are not spaced correctly.

Some people who have dyslexia see words all crushed together when they try to read.

Some people who have dyslexia say that the words on a page look shadowed or doubled when they try to read.

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Some people with dyslexia say that the words on a page look blurred from a central point when they try to read them.
