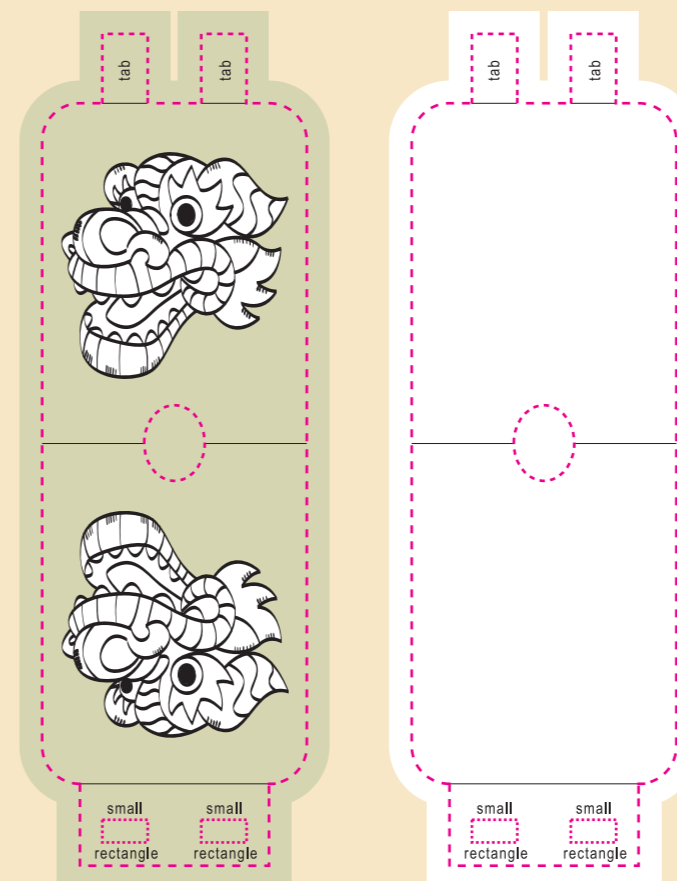
Let's Discuss!

3. Which princess has very long hair?



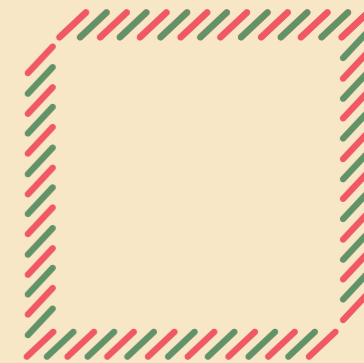
4. Who lost a glass slipper?
