OBJECTIVE

Decide what jobs the boy and girl should have by putting different clothes on them! Mix and match the different occupations using the pop-ups.



INSTRUCTIONS

Additional Materials: Colouring Pencils

- 1 Colour the boy and the girl, as well as the clothing and accessories of the different occupations.
- 2 Pop these out along the perforated lines. Do you see the red lines at the boy's and girl's feet? These will be important later.
- 3 Pop out the rectangular tabs marked 'X'.
- 4 There is a red line on each rectangular tab. Slot it into the red lines at the boy's and girl's feet (see image). Now, they can stand!
- 5 What would you like to be? A scientist? A judge? You can decide by dressing up the characters!
- 6 To dress the boy and girl, fold the parts marked 'Z' and hang the clothes on them.
