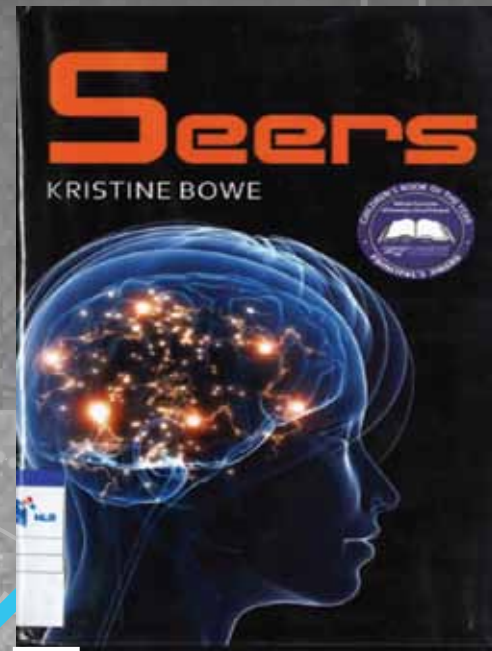

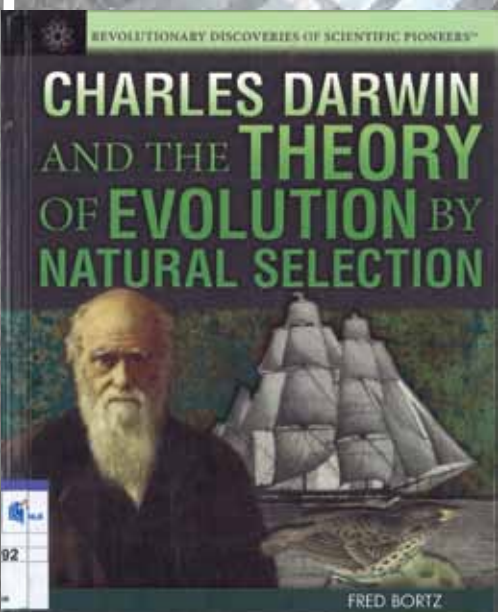


Falls the Shadow
