



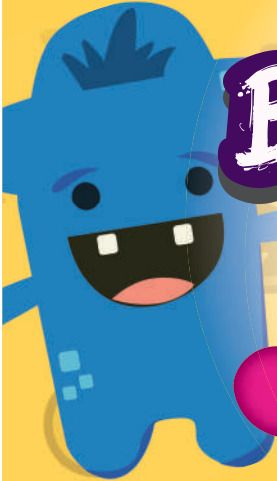

On your mobile device:

- Download NLB Mobile app
