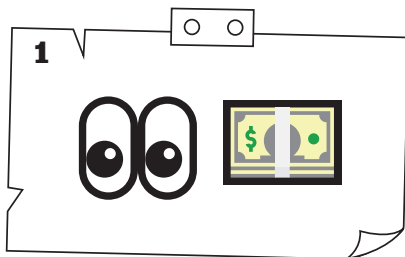


# Menyahkod Emoji

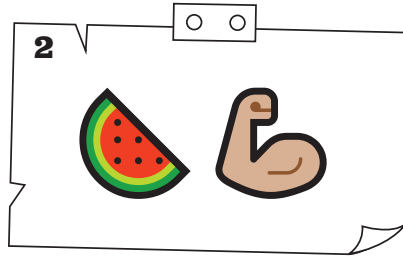
## Arahan:

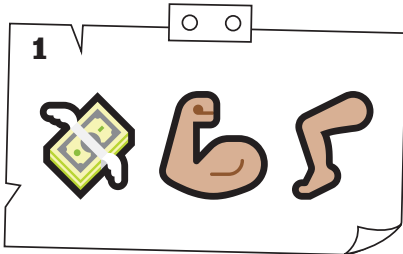


# Decode the Emoji

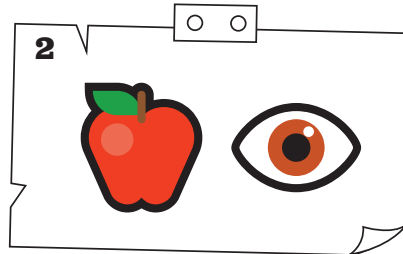
## Instructions:
