Centred on the theme of migration, these suggested reads follow the journeys of various characters – both humans and animals – through life-changing experiences.

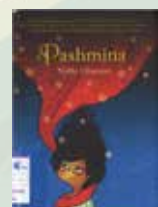
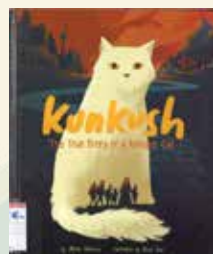
