





## THINGS YOU WILL NEED:

- A large bowl
- Food colouring
- 240ml of cornflour

Cornflour

- A spoon
- 120ml of water

Be sure to ask an adult for permission first before grabbing the things you need out of the kitchen!

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1) Pour the water into your bowl and add a few drops of food colouring. Add the cornflour, a little at a time, stirring the mixture as you go.
  - 2) Once you have added all the cornflour, the slime should solidify when it is stirred quickly. If it does not, add a little more cornflour, a spoonful at a time. Stir again and see if the tear forms.
    - 3) You've made slime!
